

220513 CT Personal Equipment Requirements

CT run under **ClubSport Basic** permit. In essence, the requirements for ClubSport Basic are:

- OVERALLS to MINIMUM level C.
- UNDERWEAR to MINIMUM level C
- SOCKS to MINIMUM level C.
- SHOES to MINIMUM level C.

FHR (Frontal Head Restraint devices) At ClubSport Basic Level, FHR devices in non-caged cars are not mandatory. FHR devices do not work with traditional lap-and-diagonal seatbelts. Drivers of vehicles with original seats and traditional lap-and-diagonal belts are permitted to participate wearing a “neck donut”.

If you have race seats, then you will need five or six point race belts. If you have a WOF, then you will need a LVV or Motorsport Authority Card and therefore, your vehicle will need a logbook.

Pukekohe currently allows track entry using a donut and race belts, however this will soon no longer be relevant. At Hampton Downs and Taupo International Raceway, it is mandatory to wear a FHR device if your vehicle has race belts/seats.

While gloves and balaclava are considered “E - No Requirement” it has become a local track rule that gloves are mandatory for track entry. **Track Marshals are under instruction to prevent track entry for competitors not wearing requisite safety equipment.** Classic Trials are often the only ClubSport Basic event at a race meeting, so while technically we are allowed to compete without gloves and balaclava, Classic Trials have taken the line that gloves (in particular) and balaclava are considered an integral component of our safety equipment and as such should be worn where and when possible.
