Chris Amon

HRC Bid a Fond Farewell to Formula 1 Hero Chris Amon

Born in Bulls in 1943, Chris was regarded as one of the best Formula One racing car drivers of his generation. Chris drove in 96 F1 races and never won a world championship Grand Prix. He won eight non-championship F1 races and numerous sports car races (including the 24 Hours of Daytona and the 24 Hours of Le Mans – for Ford, in 1966, co-driving with Bruce McLaren).

In 1976 he retired from the track and returned to the family farm in the Manawatu though he retained connections to the sport. He helped redesign the Taupo circuit, supported Toyota's TRS single-seater championship, and was celebrated at the New Zealand Festival of Motor Racing in 2011. Chris was made an MBE for his services to motorsport in 1993 and was inducted into the New Zealand Sports Hall of Fame in 1995.

This is the popular Icebreaker meeting on 10/11th September at Hampton Downs and has the following classes Arrows, AES, Alfa, Historic Formula Ford, BMW E30, BMW open 2 Itr, BMW Open, Classic Trial and All comer Saloons pre 1993. This pre 93 race is a "once only" this season for Historic Sedans, Historic Muscle Cars and Historic Saloon Cars to have a run before the various series start in earnest later on in the year. Entry Fees

You will notice when reading the Regs for this seasons events that we have made a few minor changes to the way we are going to accept payment of entries. This has been done to keep entry fees as low as possible, try and ease the queues at documentation and also help us and the series co-ordinators to be able to plan the event entry better.

The entry closing date at normal fees is now 10:00am on the Monday prior to the event. The entries must be PAID for (by either Bank Transfer, Credit Card or Cheque) and all monies to be received by HRC before the normal entry closing date.

Entries or payments received after the normal entry closing date of 10:00am on the Monday prior to the event (including ALL payment on the day) will be subject to a late fee of \$20.

No entries will be accepted after 5pm on the Friday (Day before the event).

Remember - Entries should always be done on line at www.motorsportentry.com If this is not possible, postal entries will be accepted up to 10:00am on the Monday prior to the event. Postal entries will attract a \$20.00 administration fee.

It has been interesting to note running the Endurance Series at various tracks that the cost of running an event is very similar at each track. There have been events over the winter at some tracks which have been very good value for the money but on those occasions the car club has received a concession on track hire. The basic entry fee at HRC events this year will rise by \$30. As will be noted for the Icebreaker and Waikato Challenge the entry fee is shown as \$280 plus \$50 MSNZ levy and if a Track Owner Health and Safety Levy is applied that is another extra. Classic Trial and Hooters Vintage series get an entry discount as Classic Trial pay a reduced MSNZ levy and Hooters Vintage series pay no MSNZ levy. 2K cup get a discount as they consistently supply two full fields to HRC meetings. This discount will apply to any other class that consistently provides over 35 entries. By maximising the number of entries per class and having as many entry payments in advance, we will be able to minimise any increase in entry fees.

Our aim is to promote the classes as we did at Speed Show, boost the numbers racing and grow the sport for everyone.

Tasman Revival, Hampton Downs, 14/15th January 2017

Moving forward, this event will be promoted by the Hampton Downs team and the event will be run over one weekend. This year will be a spectacular event with over 15 Historic Formula One Cars and a full grid of F5000 cars competing along with usual Historic Classic Cars - all on the new international track.

The HRC, together with the Chairman and Directors of NZFMR, extend their very sincere thanks to all those who have supported the Festival over the past seven years, as well as offering our best wishes to the team at Hampton Downs for the continued success of the Festival into the future.
